- 5. The learned Advocate for the applicant appeared today. He undertakes to remove the office objections within reasonable period.
- 6. Technically, the Registrar was right in refusing the registration since nobody appeared for the applicant in view of the objections in spite of repeated chances. The fact that the O.A. is filed challenging reversion order and in order to give an opportunity to him to prove his claim on merits, it will be in the Interest of justice to allow the appeal by condoning delay of about 96 days caused in filing this Chamber Appeal as the applicant shall not suffer for the negligence of his Advocate. Hence, the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) Delay caused in filing Chamber Appeal stands condoned. Consequently, the Chamber Appeal No. 09/2023 is allowed as the applicant undertakes to remove the office objections within a reasonable period.
- (ii) Registrar of this Tribunal Bench at Aurangabad is directed to register the O.A. after removing the office objections by the learned Advocate for the applicant and place the same before the appropriate bench for hearing.

2. Applicant has filed present Original Application challenging the order dated 28.06.2023 issued by respondent No. 3 thereby transferring the applicant from the post of Senior Clerk, Project Office, Dhule to the Project Office, Nandurbar. The applicant is working as Senior Clerk and falls in the category of Group-C employee. Learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that ordinary tenure of the employee in Group-C category is of six years and the applicant has not completed his ordinary tenure on the post at Dhule and in the circumstances could not have been transferred. Learned counsel further submitted that earlier also the applicant was transferred vide order dated 07.09.2021 from Dhule to Yawal. The applicant has challenged the said order by filing O.A. No. 537/2021 and in the said matter on 14.09.2021 this Tribunal had granted interim stay to the implementation and operation of the order impugned in the said O.A. till filing of the affidavit in reply by the respondents.

Learned counsel submitted that the said O.A. is still pending and the interim stay as has been granted in the said O.A. has been continued time to time and is still in According to the learned counsel in the force. circumstances in fact the respondents could not have issued the impugned order dated 28.06.2023. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant physically handicapped person 43% possessing permanent disablement and having regard to the said fact also the applicant could not have been transferred at the distance of about 90 Kms. From Dhule. Learned counsel further submitted that the applicant is due for retirement on 30.06.2024 i.e. within one year from the date of passing of the impugned transfer order. In view of the provisions under Section 5 (1) (a) of the Maharashtra Government Servants regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (for short 'the Transfer Act of 2005') the applicant could not have been transferred, learned counsel added. It is further contended that the applicant has not yet been relieved from his existing post and no one has yet been appointed in his place. In the circumstances, learned counsel prayed for interim relief thereby staying the effect and operation of the impugned transfer order till decision of the present Original Application.

- Shri V.R. Bhumkar, learned Presenting Officer 3. appearing for the respondent authorities has opposed for grant of any interim relief. Learned P.O. submitted that the applicant has been transferred vide the impugned order on administrative ground. Learned P.O. brought to my notice that in the order itself it has been disclosed that there were complaints against the applicant and based on that the applicant seems to have been transferred. Learned P.O. further submitted that the order passed in O.A. No. 537/2021 cannot be an impediment for passing fresh transfer order by the respondents. Learned P.O. submitted that the applicant has already been relieved i.e. on 04.07.2023 and as such, he opposed for grant any interim relief and sought time for filing affidavit in reply and place the entire material before this Tribunal which has necessitated the issuance of impugned order of transfer.
- 4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, respondents. As has been contended on behalf of the applicant, the applicant is working at Dhule since the year 2019. There may not be any dispute on the issue that for Group-C employees the ordinary tenure at one place and on one post is six years as provided under Section 3 of the Transfer Act, 2005. It is thus evident that the applicant has not

completed his ordinary tenure on the post at Dhule. However, the respondents have right and authority to transfer the Government servant even before completing his ordinary tenure at the existing post on administrative ground. In the present case the said powers seems to have invoked by the State. As has been pointed by learned P.O., the applicant seems to have been transferred because of the complaints against him, on administrative ground. It has also been submitted that the applicant has been relieved from his existing post on 04.07.2023. When it is within the power of the State Government to transfer any Government employee on administrative grounds before completing his ordinary tenure, the propriety demands that the respondents must be given an opportunity to place those reasons before the Tribunal through their affidavit in reply. In the order of transfer it is not expected that the respondents shall elaborate the reasons behind the transfer of the employee concerned.

5. Having considered the facts as aforesaid, apparently there seems no reason for considering the request of the applicant for grant of interim relief. It has been further brought to my notice by the learned counsel appearing for the applicant that the applicant is due for

retirement in the next year and more particularly on 30.06.2024. Section 5(1)(a) of the Transfer Act, 2005 provides that the employee due for transfer after completion of tenure at a station of posting or post if has less than one year for his retirement can be retained at the same station even beyond the ordinary tenure. However, even this provision will not come in the way of the Government, if on administrative ground, the Government finds it necessary to transfer the said employee. In the present matter, as is revealed from the order of transfer itself there seems to complaints against the applicant which necessitated the transfer of the applicant vide the impugned order. In the circumstances, it does not appear to me that any case is made out by the applicant for grant of any interim relief. For the reasons stated above, the following order is passed:-

ORDER

- (i) Issue notices to the respondents keeping open point of limitation, returnable on 21.7.2023.
- (ii) Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at once and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- (iii) Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on respondent/s intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of the case. Respondents are

put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

It is also the contention of the applicant that his wife is serving at Dhule and was posted at Dhule in the month of March of this year for the reason that the applicant is serving at Dhule. In the circumstances, prayer has been made by the applicant to stay effect and operation of the impugned order temporarily. In view of the fact that the transfer has been effected on administrative grounds and more particularly because of complaints received against him I am not inclined to grant any interim relief as prayed for

by the applicant. Unless the affidavit in reply is received from the respondents it may not be possible to consider

whether the applicant has been transferred genuinely on administrative ground or otherwise. Being aggrieved by the order dated 30.6.2023 2. the applicant has approached this Tribunal. applicant is working as a District Health Officer, Zilla Parishad, Beed and has been transferred vide the impugned order as District Health Officer, Zilla Parishad, Buldhana. It is the grievance of the applicant that in the impugned order it has been wrongly mentioned to have been made on request of the applicant. It is contended that the applicant on oath has submitted that he had never requested for his transfer. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that perusal of the order of the even date by which respondent no. 4 has been transferred in place of the applicant it can be gathered that on request of respondent no. 4, he has been brought at Beed. The learned counsel submitted that when the

applicant has not completed his ordinary tenure, only on the ground that someone else has shown his interest for posting at Beed, the applicant cannot be transferred. The learned counsel, in the circumstances, has prayed for interim stay to the impugned order. It is submitted that the applicant has not yet been relieved.

- 3. Shri I.S. Thorat, learned Presenting Officer submitted that the applicant has already been relieved and the respondent no. 4 has resumed on his post. The learned P.O. has submitted the necessary documents in that regard, which are taken on record.
- 4. In view of the fact that the transferred person has resumed the duties in place of the applicant, though the applicant is disputing the said position, I am not inclined to grant any interim relief in the present matter. However, I deem it appropriate to direct the respondents to file the affidavit in reply by 19.7.2023 by serving copy of the affidavit in reply in advance to the applicant so that the matter can be immediately taken up for final disposal. The

respondents shall place on record along with their affidavit in reply all the necessary documents in support of their contentions and shall not seek adjournment on the ground that some documents are required to be produced by them.

2. By filing the present O.A. the applicant has questioned the transfer of respondent No. 4 in his place. It is the contention of the applicant that he has been working on the existing post since 9.10.2020 and has not yet completed his ordinary tenure on the said post. It is his further contention that though respondent No. 4 is shown to have been transferred in his place, the applicant has not been given any further posting. It is his further contention that in the impugned order of transfer the post on which the applicant is presently working is wrongly shown to be a vacant post. circumstances, the applicant has prayed temporarily staying the effect and operation of the impugned order.

- 3. Smt. Deepali S. Deshpande, learned Presenting Officer submitted that the applicant was posted on his existing post till the regularly selected candidate from the MPSC becomes available or any other officer is duly appointed on the said post. According to the learned P.O. in the above circumstances the applicant does not possess any right to oppose the transfer order of respondent No. 4 in his place. Learned P.O. submitted that the order of transfer of the applicant is likely to be issued shortly. In the circumstances, learned P.O. has opposed for grant of any interim relief as prayed for by the applicant and has sought time to file the affidavit in reply on behalf of the respondents.
- 4. I have duly considered the submissions made on behalf of the applicant, as well as, the respondents. I have perused the documents filed on record. The order dated 9.10.2020, whereby the applicant was posted as Assistant Director of Health Services (Leprosy), Jalna reveals that the applicant was appointed on the said post by lowering the pay scale. The clauses 2 & 3 of the said order further reveal that his said appointment on the said post

was a time gap arrangement till the candidate from MPSC or duly promoted candidate is appointed on the said post. It appears that respondent No. 4 who is presently working as District Health Officer, Zilla Parishad, Aurangabad, is appointed on the post of applicant. Perusal of transfer order of respondent No. 4 shows that he has been appointed in the same pay scale and not by lowering down the pay scale as in the case of the applicant. Having regard to the facts as above prima facie it does not appear to me that any case is made out by the applicant for seeking interim stay to the transfer order of respondent No. 4. Though it is the further grievance of the applicant that he has not been posted anywhere, as has been submitted by learned P.O. posting order of the applicant is likely to be issued within a short period. I hope and trust that by the next date the posting order of the applicant will be issued by the respondents. In the circumstances, I deem it appropriate to pass the following order: -

ORDER

(i) Issue notice to respondents, returnable on 20.7.2023.
