the show cause notice, which were read by learned C.P.O. in the open court, that the authority has taken the stand to the effect that no representation is filed by the applicant, however, the same appears to be contrary to the record.

superior officer, they may be posted at some other place, irrespective of their choice, by reserving their option already exercised.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that all the applicants approached this Tribunal by filing Original Application No. 874 of 2023. By order dated 26/27.09.2023 Hon'ble Vice Chairman of this Bench has directed the respondents to update "IMV Eligible List-2023" published on 23.09.2023 by entering the remarks against the name of the present applicants evidencing that they had worked in ' Tribal area', before issuance of the orders of transfer. The Original Application came to be disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

4. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that in spite of the said order there is no communication from the respondents to the applicants as to whether their options are considered or cannot be considered or the options exercised by them is reserved at present.

5. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that when the copies of present Original Applications were served on the office of learned

C.P.O., surprisingly today itself the applicants have been relieved from their present posting.

6. Learned C.P.O. has appeared *suo motu* and on instructions submits that the order passed by the respondent authorities is proper, correct and legal and it may not be stayed at this stage without looking into the record and proceedings.
