Heard Shri S.N. Pagare, learned counsel for the applicant and Shri N.U. Yadav, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

2. When the present matter is taken up for consideration it is noticed that the impugned order of transfer dated 9.8.2021 was stayed by this Tribunal vide order passed on 13.8.2021 observing that the daughter of the applicant is studying in 12th standard and retention was sought for one year. However, the matter could not be taken for consideration for whatsoever may be reason till date and interim relief has been extended. Having regard to the pleadings of the present matter, it appears that the very purpose of filing application has been served.

3. In the above circumstances the case of the applicant now can be considered by the respondents for her transfer in ensuing annual general transfers. The respondents shall accordingly consider the case of the applicant for her transfer from the existing place on usual terms and conditions.

4. In the M.A. the applicant has prayed for her transfer on the vacant post of Assistant Commissioner (Animal Husbandry) Frozen Semen Laboratory at Harsul, Aurangabad. The Tribunal however, cannot issue any such mandate, making transfers of their employees is the prerogative of the Government and unless the action of the State is held *mala fide* or with ulterior motive ordinarily no interference is to be caused in such orders. In the circumstances, prayer as has been claimed in the M.A. cannot be granted by this Tribunal. The respondents may however, independently consider such request on its own merits.

5. The O.A. and M.A. both stand disposed of in the aforesaid terms. There shall be no order as to costs.

Heard Ms. Preeti R Wankhade, learned counsel for the applicants and Shri M.P. Gude, Smt. Sanjivani Deshmukh-Ghate and Mrs. Deepali S. Deshpande, learned Presenting Officers for the respective respondents in respective matters.

2. Since in all these matters the grievance of the applicants is common and identical prayers are made in all these matters, I have heard all these matters together and deem it appropriate to decide all these matters by common reasoning.

3. The applicants have challenged the order of their posting after their promotion to the post of Senior Assistant from the post of Senior Clerk. It is the grievance of the applicants that on promotion they have

been posted at the places at the distance of more than four hundred k.ms. from their present posting. It is the further grievance of these applicants that though all these applicants have preferred representations with the respondent authorities and similar representations were presented by similarly situated other employees who can be termed as co-employees of these applicants, while considering the request of majority of them positively, the request of the applicants has been turned down without assigning any good reason therefor. Learned Counsel for the applicants pointed out certain instances and has placed on record documents in that regard showing that the representations of the similarly situated employees have been favourably considered by the respondents and their orders of posting have been suitably changed.

4. Learned Counsel for the applicants submitted that ordinarily Class-III employees should not be transferred at such a far distance from the existing posting. Learned Counsel further submitted that the ground on which the applicants have requested for change in their posting, the request of certain employees on similar ground has been accepted but the request of the applicants has not been considered. Learned Counsel submitted that the reasons as are submitted in the representation filed by

the applicants are genuine and must have been considered by the respondents. In one matter the change in the posting has been sought on the ground of couple convenience; in other matter on the ground of serious ailment of mother; and in the another matter the posting sought to be changed on the ground that the posting is given at Jalgaon from Nanded at the distance of 400 k.ms. will be most inconvenient because there are no elderly persons to look after children of the applicant and as such, the entire responsibility is on the wife of the applicant.

5. Officer Learned Presenting has opposed contentions raised in the O.As. and the request made therein. Learned P.O. submitted that the cases of most of the employees are sympathetically considered by the respondents and utmost effort has been made to see that no inconvenience is caused to the employees. Learned P.O. submitted that since in comparison to the cases of the applicants, difficulties put-forth by the other employees were more serious, their cases have been considered and the postings are accordingly changed. However, the cases of these applicants could not be considered for want of suitable vacant posts for change in their posting.

6. During course of the arguments it was pointed out by the learned counsel for the applicants that at Parbhani new Medical College has been established and seven posts are created of the Senior Assistant. Learned Counsel submitted that the present applicants can be considered for giving them posting at the said vacant posts. It is further contended that the applicants are not claiming the posting at any particular district or place, their only request is that they may be posted at nearby places.

7. Transfer is inevitable in the career of the Government employees which cannot be every time avoided. It is however, true that the difficulties of these applicants are to be considered by the respondents. The Tribunal, has its limitation in passing orders in such matters. The difficulties of the administration cannot be lost sight of and in the circumstances in rare cases the Tribunals are supposed to cause interference in the orders of transfer or in the orders of postings.

8. From the contentions raised in the applications and the argument as has been advanced on behalf of all these applicants it appears that these applicants feel that they have not been given the same treatment which has been given to the similarly situated other employees

in their department. This feeling of being discriminatory needs to be removed. It can only be removed by the respondents by reconsidering the requests of these applicants. The applicants must know reasons may it be a rejection or acceptance of request. Moreover, a new development which has occurred during pendency of the present applications is establishment of new Medical College at Parbhani and availability of good number of posts of Senior Assistant in the said college.

9. As I noted hereinabove it cannot be permissible for this Tribunal to give any mandate for transfer at any particular place. The only direction which this Tribunal can issue is for reconsideration of the request of these applicants on equitable grounds. As such, the present applications can be disposed of with the following directions to the respondents: -

<u>O R D E R</u>

The respondents shall reconsider the request of all these applicants seeking change in their posting on the grounds mentioned in their applications and the common ground that they have been transferred at far away distance of around 400 kms and having regard to availability of the posts at the newly established

Government Medical College at Parbhani, within 6 weeks from the date of this order.

(ii) The Original Applications stand disposed of in the aforesaid terms. There shall be no order as to costs.
