- 2. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is serving on the post of Assistant Town Planner (Group C service) in the office of Municipal Council, Beed. He has been suspended by the impugned order dated 07-09-2017. He has submitted that applicant immediately filed representation dated 11-09-2017 before the Commissioner, Directorate of Municipal Administration, Mumbai i.e. respondent no.2 with a request to revoke his suspension.
- 3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that said representation has not been decided by the respondent no.2, and therefore,

the applicant has challenged the impugned order of suspension by filing the present O.A. He has submitted that in view of the provisions of Section 20 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, O.A. is maintainable, and therefore, he prayed to admit the O.A.

4. Learned P.O. has submitted that the suspension order is appealable in view of Rule 17 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Discipline & Appeal) Rules, 1979 ["M.C.S. (D. & A.) Rules" for short] and appellate authority is provided under Rule 18 of the M.C.S. (D. & A.) Rules, 1979. He has submitted that the applicant has not challenged the impugned order by preferring the appeal though that remedy is available to him. Instead of that, he had filed an application before respondent no.2 for revocation of the suspension order in view of the provisions of 4(5)(c) of M.C.S. (D. & A.) Rules, 1979. He has submitted that since representation of the applicant İS pending, present O.A. is not maintainable in

view of Section 20(2)(b) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

5. I have gone through the provisions of Rule 4(5)(c) of M.C.S. (D. & A.) Rules, 1979, which reads as under:

### "4. Suspension-,

- (1) .....
- (2) .....
- (3) .....
- (4) .....
- (5) (a) .....
  - (b) .....
  - (c) An order of suspension made or deemed to have been made under this rule may at any time be modified or revoked by the authority, which made or is deemed to have made the order or by any authority to which that authority is subordinate.

[Provided that, where a criminal offence is registered against a Government servant, the recommendation of the Supervision Review Committee constituted by the Government in this behalf shall be obtained by the authority which has made or is deemed to have made the suspension order by or any authority to which that authority is subordinate, before revoking or modifying the order of suspension of such Government servant.]"

6. The applicant has approached respondents by filing application/representation to revoke the order of suspension by resorting to the provisions of Rule 4(5)(c) of M.C.S. (D. & A.) Rules. Therefore, the application is not maintainable in view of the provisions of Section 20(2)(b) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985, which reads as under:

### "20. Application not to be admitted unless other remedies exhausted :-

(1)	)						
. ,							

(2) For the purposes of sub-section (1), a person shall be deemed to have availed of all the remedies available to him under the relevant service rules as to redressal of grievances,-

- (a) .....
- (b) where no final order has been made by the Government or other authority or officer or other person competent to pass such order with regard to the appeal preferred or representation made by such person, if a period of six months from the date on which such appeal was preferred or representation was made has expired."
- 7. The applicant has not challenged the impugned order by preferring the appeal as provided under Rule 17 & 18 of the M. C. S.

- (D. & A.) Rules but the applicant has chosen to file representation with the respondent no.2 for revocation of the impugned order. Said representation is still pending with the respondent no.2. The applicant has not availed the remedy of appeal as provided under M.C.S. (D. & A.) Rules. Moreover, the present O.A. cannot be entertained and admitted by this Tribunal in view of the provisions of Section 20(1) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, as the applicant has not availed all the remedies available to him.
- 8. In Section view of 20(2)(b) of the Administrative Tribunals Act cause of action to file O.A. arises after six months from the date of filing the representation till one year. Before expiry of statutory period, as provided under Section 22(b), the applicant has approached the Tribunal by filing the present O.A. As the O.A. is premature, the same is not maintainable. Likewise, the O.A. cannot be admitted in view of

the provisions of Section 20(1) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

- 9. In view of the abovesaid discussion, in my opinion, present O.A. is not maintainable in view of provisions of Section 20 of the Administrative Tribunal Act. Hence, the O.A. stands rejected.
- 10. Since the O.A. is rejected, nothing survives in the M.A. M.A. stands dismissed.
