9. In effect, the matter came to be decided and communicated to the applicant vide communication dated 6.8.2016 (P.570, A.4)-High Court order (P.441, A.32). The grudge and grievance of the applicant is that,

though there is a specific direction by the Hon'ble High Court that the matter be decided by the D.G.P., but communication reveals that the matter is looked into by the Additional D.G.P. (Establishment). He further urged that thus the order of the High Court is not followed in letter and spirit.

10. The matter has а chequered history. The applicant is knocking the doors of various Courts for about a decade. Initially he has filed O.A. No. 602/2008 before the Tribunal at Aurangabad which is allowed and decided in his favour on 3.8.2011. The learned P.O. submitted that the writ petition filed against the said decision was also dismissed and now the matter is pending in S.L.P.

11. In the second round of litigation, the applicant has filed O.A. No.763/2010 before this Bench which came to be dismissed on 30.4.2015 (P.404). Against this decision, the applicant has filed this O.A. which is decided with the above observations.

12. It is worthwhile to note that, a question of *inter se* seniority amongst the direct recruits and promotee is involved. The Aurangabad

Bench of this Tribunal has decided the point of seniority of the applicant in the cadre of Dy. S.P. and S.P. In the communication present dated 11.10.2010 the seniority of the in the capacity of P.S.I. is applicant touched and decided. The learned counsel for the applicant urged that the seniority was already decided in the above litigation by Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal in the cadre of Dy. S.P. and S.P. By the impugned communication, the seniority of P.S.I. is in year 1996 touched which affects his career. Considering the nature of issue involved which is lingering since in respect of seniority of the long superior officers, the Hon'ble High Court has given direction that aspect should be decided by the D.G.P. Under such circumstances, the D.G.P. should have decided the same. But it does not reveal SO from the communication. This submission holds water.

13. Anyhow, fact remains that in such a chequered facts, it will always be desirable to avoid further complications. Moreover, the applicant is being protected by the order of this Tribunal and then by the High Court.

The applicant apprehends that now the order of reversion may be passed which may affect his career. It is also apprehended that the orders may be passed immediately. Apprehension cannot be ruled out.

14. All the aspects can be well considered and everything will be clear on filing of the reply.

15. In the above state of affairs, *status quo* as on today in respect of posting of the applicant be maintained till filing of the reply.
