2. By consent of Id. Counsel for both the sides, the matter is heard and decided finally at the stage of admission.

3. The transfer order dtd. 21/4/2016 (Annexure-A-1, Page-14) is under challenge by which the applicant, Tahsildar, is transferred from Arjuni Morgaon to Gondia.

The challenge to 4. the Firstly, the order order is two fold. being issued in April, is mid-term. Secondly, the applicant was working the posting at present from December, 2015 and has not No completed the tenure. compliance under Section 4 (4)(5) of

the Maharashtra Govt. Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the Transfer Act ) is made and the order is issued by the Divisional Commissioner, Nagpur Division, i.e., R/2.

There is no gainsaying 5. of these facts. However, the respondents' that the case is Commissioner is vested with the power to issue the transfer order vide G.R. dtd. 17/12/2014. Under the said G.R., the Divisional Revenue Commissioner is empowered to issue the general transfer order only but the order in the case in hand is mid-tenure and mid-term which

requires compliance of the above legal provisions and that is not done.

It is also urged that R/4 6. is transferred vide order dtd. 19/8/2016 and he joined at Arjuni Morgaon and the applicant was relieved on 22/4/2016 (Annexure-R-3, Page-49). Respondent No. 4 has not filed the reply. It is well settled that the joining and relieving does not assume any significance while considering the legality and validity of the transfer order. In effect, no much capital can be made of aspect of the joining and relieving. That aspect cannot be decisive one because it will tantamount to vest with the authority to decide the legality and validity of the order and to denude the court of that power.

7. It is also urged that the order dtd. 19/8/2016 is issued after complying the provisions. However, the impugned order dtd. 21/4/2016 is not legal and valid the subsequent order dtd. 19/8/2016 in place of the transferring R/4 applicant though issued after complying the provisions, cannot confer right to R/4 to join on the post of the applicant.

8. The respondents' case is that the transfer is made on the administrative exigency as the applicant is failed to handle the law and order problem. No doubt, such reason can be a good ground but that does not absolve the authority to comply the provisions of Section 4(4)(5) of the Transfer

act of taking prior approval and recording reasons etc. which is not done in this case.

9. Viewed from any angle, both the orders cannot be said to be legal and valid because when the first order dtd. 21/4/2016 is not valid, the right is accrued in favour of the applicant to continue on that post and posting of R/4 cannot be continued on the same post. Consequently, both the orders are quashed. In effect the applicant be given posting to Arjuni Morgaon . The order be complied with within 2 weeks. Accordingly the O.A. is allowed with no order as to costs.
