- 1. This Original Application has been filed by one Dr. Shukracharya Gokul Dudhal on 14.10.2019 invoking provisions of S. 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 essentially challenging following two orders passed by Respondent No.1 and praying for reinstatement, confirmation and grant of all consequential benefits:

 - ii. Order passed by Respondent No.1 dated21.09.2019 in compliance with the order of thisTribunal in Original Application No.126 of 2018.
