- 7. On behalf of the applicants, for grant of interim relief, reliance is placed on the order dated 4/7/2023 passed by the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal in a batch of three O.As. Following interim order was passed by the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal –
- "(1) Issue notices to the respondents, returnable on 25.7.2023, till then the respondents shall allow the applicants to perform their duties at their existing posts."
- 8. It is submitted by learned CPO that before the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal the details which have been today placed before this Bench by communication dated 6/7/2023 were probably not placed.
- 9. The communication dated 6/7/2023 along with minutes of meeting held on 23/5/2023 shows that representations made by the applicants were considered and rejected.
- 10. The question is whether interim order like the one passed by the Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal should be passed in this batch of O.As. It would be advisable to defer the question of grant of interim order till the next date. The CPO shall make a statement whether or not procedure under Section 4 (2) of the Transfers Act, 2005 was followed.
