The grievance of the applicant is that as per his qualification he should have been absorbed in Class-III post, his case has been recommended by Deputy Commissioner, E.G.S., Nagpur Division, Nagpur vide letter dated 10.11.2021 (A-7, Pg. No. 31).

3. Hence, Respondent no. 3 is directed to decide the representation of the applicant dated 15.06.2021 (A-6, Pg. No. 30) within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order which has been already recommended by Deputy Commissioner, E.G.S., Nagpur Division, Nagpur vide letter dated 10.11.2021 (A-7, Pg. No. 31).

 Issue notice to Respondents, returnable on six weeks. Learned P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

5. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

6. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of

hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

7. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

8. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

9. In case notice is not collected within <u>three</u> <u>days</u> and if service report on affidavit is not filed <u>three days</u> before returnable date. Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
