2. Ld. C.P.O. has filed document sent by Under Secretary, M.P.S.C. dated 18.08.2022. However, ld. counsel for the applicant is insisting to grant Interim Relief and requested that direction be given to respondents to allow the applicant to appear in the Interview to be held on 22.08.2022. The ld. counsel for the applicant has submitted that applicant is eligible for the post of Professor (Ophthalmology) but she is not allowed to appear in the Interview vide communication published on website. Therefore, she approached to this Tribunal.

3. Heard ld. C.P.O., Shri S.A.Deo, he has filed communication dated 18.08.2022 which is marked Exh. "X" for the purpose of identification. It is taken on record. Copy is supplied to the other side. As per submission of ld. C.P.O. applicant is not eligible for the post of Professor (Ophthalmology) therefore, she cannot be permitted to appear in the Interview to be held on 22.08.2022.

4. The letter dated 18.08.2022 shows that applicant is not eligible for the post of Professor (Ophthalmology) the relevant portion of the letter is reproduced below:-

“प्रस्तुत पदासाठी प्राप्त अर्जाची छाननी संबंधित विषयातील तज्ञांकडून करण्यात आली आहे. विषयांकीत पदाच्या अर्हतेनुसार भारतीय आर्युविज्ञान परीषदेच्या दिनांक ३१ ऑक्टोबर, २०१८ व दिनांक १२ फेब्रुवारी २०२० रोजीच्या अधिसूचनेनुसार उमेदवाराकडे सहयोगी प्राध्यापक पदावर कार्यरत असताना किमान दोन विहित शोधनिबंध/प्रकाशने असणे आवश्यक आहे. डॉ धाबर्डे यांनी अर्जात एकूण ७ शोधनिबंध/प्रकाशने असल्याचा दावा केलेला आहे. परंतु तज्ञांकडून डॉ. धाबर्डे यांनी सादर केलेल्या शोधनिबंध/प्रकाशने यांची तपासणी केली असता सात पैकी सहयोगी प्राध्यापक पदावर कार्यरत असतानाच्या कालवधीतील फक्त एकच शोधनिबंध/प्रकाशन जाहिरातीतील तरतुदीनुसार ग्रह्य आहे, असा अहवाल दिला आहे (प्रत सोबत जोडली आहे.) छाननी तज्ञांच्या अहवालानुसार डॉ. धाबर्डे यांच्याकडे जाहिरातीतील तरतुदीनुसार विहित प्रकाशने/शोधनिबंध नसल्याच्या कारणास्तव अपात्र ठरल्या आहेत.”

5. As applicant is not eligible for the post of Professor (Ophthalmology) therefore, relief cannot be granted to the applicant.

6. Hence, **O.A. is disposed of with no order as to costs.**

2. Ld. P.O. has filed document from Government Desk Officer, Revenue and Forest Department dated 11.08.2022. It is taken on record. Copy is served to the other side. Vide this letter it appears that respondents have admitted giving promotion to Shri Suryakant Yeole and Shri N.D.Gangurde against whom also A.C.B. enquiry was going on. Shri Yeole was promoted vide order dated 28.02.2013 (Pg. No. 42) and Shri N.D.Gangurde was promoted vide order dated 26.04.2021 (Pg. No. 24). By record it also appears that Shri Amol C. Gawali was also promoted vide order dated 05.08.2021 (Pg. No. 26) who was facing charges on A.C.B. case.

3. On perusal of promotion order of Shri S.Yeole it appears that Government has used G.A.D. Circular dated 02.04.1976 and 22.04.1976.

4. Ld. counsel for the applicant has filed on record copy of Judgment in W.P. (C) No. 21795 of 2021 of Hon'ble High Court Orissa, Bench at Cuttack in case of Dr. Sushama Barik Vs. State of Odisha and Another passed on 03.08.2021 which is attached at page no. 64 (A-8). In this Judgment in para no. 6 elaborate discussion has been done which is reproduced below:-

*"Fact involving the case reveals that there is no disciplinary proceeding pending against the petitioner except the vigilance proceeding pending in the court of Special Judge, Vigilance, Cuttack in T.R. Case No. 36 of 2010 arising out of Cuttack Vigilance P.S. Case No. 24 of 2006. Involving the allegation against the petitioner, it appears the Vigilance Proceeding initiated in the year 2006, but charge-sheet involving the*

*Vigilance case was submitted in the year 2010. However, the said vigilance case is yet to be disposed of. Pleading also further made clear that no Disciplinary Proceeding pending against the petitioner. In this background of case an allegation is made that promotion of the petitioner taking effect in the year 2014 has been kept in sealed cover only on the premises that a vigilance proceeding involving the petitioner is pending since 2006. For the settled position of law, this court in disposal of the writ petition observes, petitioner cannot suffer for the long pendency of the vigilance proceeding. It is also not known when the Vigilance Proceeding initiated in the year 2006 will come to end. It is keeping in this view, this Court in disposal of the writ petition directs the Principal Secretary to Govt. of Odisha, General Administration and Public Grievances Department, Bhubaneswar-O.P. No. 1 and Principal Secretary to Government, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Odisha Secertariat, Bhubaneswar, opposite party no. 2 to give promotions to the petitioner to the rank of OAS-I (SB) from 30.10.2014, OAS (Supertime Scale) from 30.12.2007 and OAS (SAG) from 25.06.2021) from the date of her juniors and batchmates got such promotions. **However the promotion of the petitioner as per direction of this Court shall be subject to the ultimate outcome in the Vigilance Proceeding.** Further it is also clarified that the promotions given to the petitioner to different rank shall not confer equity in the event, she will ultimately lose the Vigilance Proceeding. Entire exercise shall be completed within four weeks from the date of communication of this direction. It is also clarified that upon promotions, petitioner shall also be entitled to all consequential benefits.”*

5. Ld. counsel for the applicant has filed letter of Divisional Commissioner dated 20.08.2018 and in para ‘क’ following observation has been made which is reproduced below:-



“क) श्री नवनाथ दत्तात्रय कातकडे, तत्का. नायब तहसिलदार (नियमित), तहसिल कार्यालय, भंडारा यांच्याविरुद्ध सुरु असलेल्या विभागीय चौकशीतून त्यांना दोषमुक्त करण्यात येऊन विभागीय चौकशीचे प्रकरण बंद करण्यात येत आहे.”

6. So, D.E. against the applicant has been already closed. Id. counsel for the applicant has also relied on order of M.A.T., Principal Bench in O.A. No. 470/2020. Para no. 5 of the said order is reproduced below:-

*“5. The respondents are directed to open the sealed cover kept by the D.P.C. in 2018 and 2019 on or before 07.01.2021 and if the applicant is found fit for promotion to the post of Tahsildar, then he be promoted immediately along with consequential service benefits, in accordance with law. The decision taken by the respondents be communicated to the applicant within two weeks thereafter.”*

7. The Id. counsel for the applicant has also relied M.A.T., Principal Bench Judgment in O.A. No. 550/2016 decided on 07.12.2016 by Division Bench. The said Judgment has also granted same kind of relief to applicant Shri Sanjay Krishnarao Patil considering longer period of case pending against the applicant.

8. The spirit behind all the above Judgments are that if any inquiry which is likely to take longer period and if at the end applicant gets exonerated he/her prime period of his/her career gets over during long drawn process of such inquiry and so applicants are given relief on various condition stipulated in the Judgments. In view of this, we feel that O.A. in hand is fully covered by above quoted Judgments and hence following order:-

### **ORDER**

1. The respondents are directed to open the sealed cover kept by the D.P.C. in 2015/past D.P.C. and if the applicant is found fit for promotion to the post of Tahsildar as per C.Rs. grading, then he be

promoted immediately along with his batchmates or juniors were promoted. However, it is made clear that the promotion of the petitioner is as per direction of this Tribunal hence it shall be subject to the ultimate outcome in the case proceedings. However, applicant will be entitled for all consequential service benefits, in accordance with law. The decision taken by the respondents be communicated to the applicant within one month from the date of receipt of this order and file it on record before this Tribunal.

2. Hence, **C.P. stands disposed of with no order as to costs.**
