2. The ld. counsel for the applicant has filed merit list of Police Recruitment 2019 qualified for physical test. He is relying on page no. 150 wherein last open female candidate is at Sr. No. 482 bearing roll No. 211910765, Ms. Tutuja Vilas Nilatkar and she has obtained 63 marks. The ld. counsel for the applicant submits that applicant has obtained 75 marks. Applicant is at 10th number bearing numbering 2115426542 and she has scored 75 marks. Comparing these two documents, it is clear that applicant appears to be more meritorious then last Open Female Candidate in the list. This squarely covers Judgements given by Hon'ble Apex Court in Sauray Yaday Vs. State of Uttar Pradesh in Miscellaneous Application No. 2641 of 2019 in Special Leave Petition (Civil) no. 23223 of 2018 decided on 18.12.2020. Subsequent to the Hon'ble Apex Court Judgement, Government has modified policy of Government Circular dated 13.08.2014 and issued new G.R. dated 19.12.2018 in which various Judicial decision have been quoted including Hon'ble Apex Court Judgement and on page no. 2 it has been clearly mentioned in corrigendum that previously it was for horizontal

reservation among eligible candidates only Open Category, Female Candidates were to be taken. But after this G.R. and corrigendum in this G.R. this open category has been replaced as per merit. Since, in this case applicant has scored 75 marks and last Female candidate in Open Category has scored only 63 marks. Obviously the applicant stood to be more meritorious then the open candidate.

- 5. Subsequently, Government has issued letter dated 22.09.2020 and in para no. 2.4; Hon'ble Apex Court Judgment has been also quoted. As submitted by Id. counsel for the applicant on page no. 169 and in para no. 2.2; it is clearly mentioned that in the category of Assistant Labour Commissioner, Group-A. There are total 71 posts from which 22 posts are vacant and that is affecting in the department. Considering all these aspects; Government has taken decision in as per para no. 2.4 and mainly in para no. 4 that as special case should be recommended to M.P.S.C. for the waiting list even after one year. Since as per merit, applicant is at Sr. No. 1 and in the last line of the said letter also says that it is again requested to send the name of the applicant and not obeying order of Government is not proper by M.P.S.C.. Hence, M.P.S.C. is directed to considered the request of the Government letter dated 06.07.2020 (A-16, Pg. No. 166) and 22.09.2020 (A-17, Pg. No. 168) and

recommend the name of the applicant within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of this order.

6. With these directions, **O.A. stands disposed of with no order as to costs.**
