2. The impugned order is dated 06.04.2023 (Annexure A-1). It is submitted that though this order is dated 06.04.2023 the respondents started recovery from the month of November, 2022 itself. The recovery has been initiated on the ground that excess payment was made to the applicant on account of wrong pay fixation. It is submitted that the applicant retired in the year 2014 and he was holding a Group-C post of Assistant Sub-Inspector. It is contended that in view of these facts recovery is apparently bad-in-law. In support of this submission reliance is placed on Tarachand s/o Urkudaji Gajbhiye Vs. State of Maharashtra and Others 2021(2) Mh.L.J. 319 (Bombay High Court). In this case the Hon'ble Bombay High Court has relied on the case of the Hon'ble Supreme Court i.e. State of Punjab and Others Vs. Rafiq Masih 2014 Mh.L.J. Online (SC) 47.
