- 2. As per the submission of learned counsel for the applicants, the applicants are to be terminated today itself as per order dated 29.08.2023.
- 3. The learned counsel for the applicants has pointed out decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Himachal Pradesh State Electricity Board, Shimla and Others VsTirath Rai and Others.*
- 4. The learned counsel for the applicants has submitted that this Tribunal (M.A.T.) has Jurisdiction to entertain and decide the matter. He has pointed out Section 24 of Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 and submitted that interim order can be passed by this Tribunal.
- 5. The learned P.O. has submitted that the applicants are labours as defined under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 and, therefore, Jurisdiction is at Labour Court and not at this Tribunal.
- 6. Section 24 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 is in respect of granting interim relief. This Section is applicable when the Tribunal has Jurisdiction. In the present matter there is no dispute that applicants are/were daily wagers. They are labours as defined under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. As per the *Maharashtra Recognition of Trade Unions and Prevention of Unfair Labour Practices Act, 1971*, the Labour Court has Jurisdiction to decide the matter in respect of termination/dismissal etc.,whereas the Industrial Court has Jurisdictionin respect of item nos. 2 to 10. The applicants are labours and, therefore, they have to approach before the Labour Court and not before the Administrative Tribunal.One of the order of termination is reproduced below-

- 7. From the perusal of the impugned orders, it is clear that the applicants are/were working with the respondents as a Daily wagers. No work is available with the respondents and, therefore, their services are/were terminated. The impugned order can be challenged before the Labour Court and not before this Tribunal.
- 8. The above cited decision in the case of Himachal Pradesh State Electricity Board (supra) is not applicable to the case in hand because in the cited Judgment it was grievances of the respondents that they were working as Clerk, they were performing the duties of the post of Clerks in the appellant's Board, they were not being paid the salaries on a par with regular clerks. Therefore, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has held that it is the Jurisdiction of Administrative Tribunal and not the High Court. In the present matter, the applicants are labours and as defined under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. It is the Jurisdiction of Labour Court. Therefore, this Tribunal cannot entertain the O.A. Hence, the O.A. along with C.A. stand dismissed with no order as to costs.
