He has pointed out order dated 9/11/2010 (Annex-A-7,P-44). As per this order, the applicant was temporarily promoted on the post of PSI and his name is at Sr.No.2. The learned counsel has pointed out list of proposed promotion order dated 29/3/2022 (P-18). The ld. counsel has submitted that the applicant is not shown in that list in zone of consideration for promotion. The learned counsel submitted that the applicant's name is not shown in the said list to be promoted on permanent basis on the post of PSI. The learned counsel submitted that the applicant is working on the post of PSI since 2010 and he is likely to be reverted and therefore prayed to grant status quo in respect of promotional post who is occupied since 2010.
- 3. The learned CPO strongly objected to grant interim relief. He has pointed out proposed promotion list dated 29/3/2022 and submitted that there is no prayer in the O.A. that his name should be included in the said list and therefore interim relief cannot be granted.
- 4. From the documents on record, it appears that the applicant has been temporarily promoted after conducting examination. The applicant scored 152 marks and he is second in the merit list and as per order dated 9/11/2010 the applicant was temporarily promoted on the post of PSI. His name is at Sr.No.2. It appears that after conducting the examination the applicant is promoted on the post of PSI, but in the proposed list of promotion dated 29/3/2022 his name is not shown.

- 5. In that view of the matter, the interim relief as prayed is granted. The respondents are directed not to disturb the promotional post of the applicant on which he is occupied since 2010 till filing of reply.
