After decision of Principal Bench and rejection of Review Application and not getting the order overruled by the Hon'ble High Court rather giving advice by Law and Judiciary Department not to appeal before the Hon'ble High Court. It is cleared that order passed by the Hon'ble M.A.T., Mumbai Bench in O.A. 576/2015 on 3/2/2016 has attained the finality of judicial procedure. After this, the respondents had no choice but to follow the orders of Hon'ble M.A.T., Mumbai Bench in O.A. 576/2015 delivered on 3/2/2016.

6. In view of discussions in above paras, the respondents complied the order of Hon'ble M.A.T., Mumbai and issued G.R. dated 28/5/2018 (A-4,P-32). Now this Judgment should be treated as Judgment in rem for similarly placed all employees to avoid wastage

2. The ld. counsel for the applicant has pointed out select list on P.B., Pg. No. 14, where 22 candidates have been selected in Class - IV Category from Kotwal Category. The applicant was appointed as Kotwal vide letter dated 27.08.2007 (Annnexure-A-2, P.B., Pg. No. 15) in Taluka Jodmoha, Tahsil-Kadam, District-Yavatmal. The applicant was working as Kotwal since 27.08.2007 and he was expecting to be selected in Class-IV post of Peon as per select list of P.B., Pg. No. 14. However, his name was not considered and all the candidates name appears on P.B., Pg. No. 14 are from vertical reserve category. Applicant's grievance is that how come there was not a single open post or open vacancy to be filled in?

As requested by Id. counsel for the applicant, **respondents are directed to make it clear the selected candidates that any appointment will be subject to the outcome of this O.A.**

4. Issue notice to Respondents, returnable on <u>six weeks</u>. Learned C.P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

5. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

6. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.
