- 5. The applicant preferred an appeal before this Tribunal in O.A. No. 810/2018 (P.B., Pg. No. 76) this O.A. along with other O.As. was decided and matter was decided on 24.02.2020 and operative part of order is at P.B., Pg. No. 88, which is reproduced below:-
- "The respondent no. 3 the Collector, Amravati is directed to fix the seniority of the respondent nos. 5 to 12 (in O.A. No. 956/2017) and all the applicants in O.A. Nos.

The applicant was given relief by respondent no. 2, as per order dated 05.05.2017, but in review he was denied relief vide order dated 01.10.2018 and this impugned order was challenged in the MAT in 0.A. No. 810/2018 and order was passed on 24.02.2020. The applicant's seniority position has been changed several times due to his appeal and order as on today applicant is working as Naib Tahsildar. Due to impugned order dated 01.10.2018, his position might be disturbed. In view of this, the applicant has apprehension that he will be aggrieved again. In view of this, respondents are directed not to disturb position of applicant again as a Naib Tahsildar and maintain Status-quo till final outcome of the 0.A..
- 7. However, respondent no. 3 is at liberty to review the order dated 04.01.2021 (Annexure-A-10, P.B., Pg. No. 98) in view of MAT order dated 24.02.2020.
