- 2. On dated 16.07.2019, the Id. counsel for the applicant is relied upon the Judgment of MAT, Nagpur in O.A. No. 90/2017 delivered on 05.05.2017 in para no. 15 it has been observed as:-
- 15. As already observed by the Hon'ble Apex Court after considering the scheme and provisions of the Bombay Home Act, 1947, it is difficult to hold that the members of Home Guard Organization is the State Government servant and the organization is meant to be voluntary and it consisted of people from all walks of life. The voluntary nature is a basic feature of the Home Guards and there is nothing to show or even to suggest that master servant relationship between the members of the association and the Government. The services being voluntary, the applicants will not get any pay, but duty allowances as may be fixed by the State Government from time to time. Since the members of the Association have voluntarily accepted to serve, they cannot insist the Government to pay particular amount as remuneration for their work.
- 3. In view of the above, O.A. is not maintainable in this Tribunal. However, the Id. counsel for the applicant is at liberty to file application before proper forum.

4. In view of the above directions, **O.A. is disposed of with no order as to costs.**
