According to the applicant he desire to join but he was prevented by respondent not to join duty. The enquiry committee should examine this issue by calling the applicant and respondents should consider all the documents presented by them.

5. After considering all the documents, enquiry committee arrive at the conclusion that whether the applicant was genuinely absent from the duty from 23.06.2017 to 01.02.2021 or he was prevented from not to join on duty. The report should be prepared **within 60 days from the date of receipt of this order**. Copy of report should be signed by Head of Institution and filed before this Tribunal through ld. P.O. **S.O. after 60 days.**"
