- 2. The learned counsel for the applicant has pointed out the order passed by the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, Mumbai dated 14.12.2022 in O.A.No.1246/2022. The Principal Bench Mumbai recorded reasons in para 3 read as under-
  - 3. Though the applicant has completed 8 years tenure in Kolhapur range as Police Inspector, he is not transferred in general transfers which were to be done in the month of April or May of every year as per the provisions of Maharashtra Police Act. The applicant was continued at Solapur (Rural) but now abruptly by order dated 09.12.2022 is transferred to Mumbai. The perusal of order reveals that near about 225 Police Personnel were transferred stating that they have completed their normal tenure. Thus, if the applicant was due for transfer then on that ground of completion of tenure, transfer could have been done in the month of April or May as provided in Maharashtra Police Act but having not done so, impugned order partakes the character of midterm transfer.
- 4. After passing the order dated 14.12.2022, all the transfers are cancelled by order dated 09.12.2022 and fresh transfer order dated 15.12.2022 is issued. The name of applicant is at serial number 91 of the transfer order.
- 5. The learned counsel for the applicant has pointed out Section 22 N(c) of Maharashtra Police Act,1951. As per this provision the normal tenure of Police Inspector for transfer is 8 years in a range. As per the submission of learned counsel for the applicant, the applicant has completed 6 years in

Amravati Range. Therefore, he was not due for transfer, no reason is given in the impugned transfer order.

- 6. From the perusal of order passed by the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, Mumbai dated 14.12.2022, it appears that the transfer order dated 09.12.2022 was midterm transfer. Therefore, it was cancelled by order dated 14.12.2022 and fresh order dated 15.12.2022 is issued, no reason for mid-term transfer is given. As per the submission of learned counsel for the applicant, the applicant is not relieved to join the transfer posting. Hence, the impugned transfer order in respect of the applicant only is stayed till filing of reply.
