- 2. As per the submission of learned counsel for applicant, the respondents have started the recovery of pension amount which was fixed at the time of retirement. The applicant was working in the naxalite area and there he was getting promotional pay as per the G.R. dated 6/8/2002. On the basis of last pay drawn, the pension was fixed. The intention of the G.R. dated 6/8/2002 is to grant some more pay to the employees who actually work in the naxalite area. As per the G.R. dated 6/8/2002 the retired persons cannot get more pay. This Tribunal has rejected the prayer of recovery in another matters.
