The case of the applicant in short is as follows:-

The applicant was working as a Mustering Assistant w.e.f. 01/07/1992. His service was discontinued. Therefore, he approached to the Labour Court. As per the order of Labour Court dt.29/03/1994, the applicant was continued in service. As per the G.R. of 1995, the applicant was absorbed in the regular service on the post of Tahsil Office,

Lakhandur in Class-IV post. The service of the applicant from the initial date of appointment from 1992 is not taken into consideration. Therefore, the applicant will not get pensionary benefits. Therefore, the applicant prayed for to count his service from the date of his initial engagement as Mustering Assistant w.e.f.01/07/1992.

The O.A. is strongly opposed by the respondents. Ld. P.O. has submitted that as per the G.R. of 1995, Mustering Assistants were absorbed in the regular service. The G.R. itself is very clear that their previous service shall not be count for any other benefits. Therefore, the applicant is not entitled for the relief as prayed.

Heard Shri Saboo, ld. counsel for the applicant. He has pointed out the judgment in W.P. No. 8468/2015 decided on 16/12/2015. Ld. P.O. has also pointed out other judgments and the reasons in the order dt.7/9/2022

are mentioned by the Supreme Court in the case of Shaikh Miya s/o Shaikh Chand -Vs- State of Maharashtra.

The ld. counsel for the applicant has submitted that in view of the judgment of Hon'ble Bombay High Court and Hon'ble Supreme Court, directions were given to the respondents to count the service for the purpose of pensionary benefits.

Heard Shri Sainis, ld. P.O.for the respondents. He has strongly objected the O.A. As per his submission, G.R. of 1995 is very clear. As per the condition in the G.R., the service of the Mustering Assistant from their initial appointment cannot be considered for the purpose of pensionary benefits and they are regularised in the service and during the service they are ------

Now, the issue of Mustering Assistant is settled by the Judgment of Bombay High Court, Bench at Aurangabad in W.P.No. 8468/2015 (State of Maharashtra and 7 others – vs. U.N. Vendait)-----, the Hon'ble Aurangabad Bench has held that services of Muster Assistant shall be counted from their initial date of engagement as a Muster Assistant for the purpose of pensionary

benefits. Now. the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of Shaikh Miya s/o Shaikh Chand -Vs- State of Maharashtra has held that in case of Muster Assistants, the notional date shall be 31/03/1997 for the purpose of pensionary benefits. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has given that the Muster Assistants directions who are absorbed in the regular service, they shall be entitled to get pensionary benefits counting their date of appointment from 31.03.1997. In view of judgment of the supreme Court the following order is passed:-

The O.A. is allowed. The impugned order dt.31/01/2020 issued by the Collector, Bhandara & the order dtd.06/07/2020 issued by the Thasildar, Latur are hereby quashed and set aside.

The Respondents are directed to count the service of the applicant from 31/03/1997 for the purpose of pensionary benefits only.
