2. By the impugned orders amount of three increments given to the applicant is sought to be recovered. It is submitted on behalf of the applicant that this recovery cannot be made and increments were rightly given to the applicant.

5. Respondents 1 to 4 shall release salary of the applicant for the months of October 2022 to December 2022, and also continue to pay salary to the applicant regularly thereafter, as per proposed re-fixation without prejudice to the rights of the applicant.
8. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable **after four weeks**. Learned C.P.O. waives notice for State. Hamdast allowed.
9. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

10. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

11. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
