2. Heard Shri S.P. Palshikar, Id. Counsel for the applicant. He has submitted that the applicant is working at Daga Memorial Government Hospital, Nagpur having additional charge of Civil Surgeon. By the impugned order dtd.11.11.2022, she is transferred from Nagpur to Mumbai on the post of Deputy Director. The Id. counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant is due for retirement on 30/06/2023. He has pointed out Section 5 of the Maharashtra Govt. Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 ( hereinafter referred to as the Transfer Act, 2005)

3. The Id. counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant will not get pensionary benefits within time after transfer. He has pointed out the letter dtd.04/10/2022 issued to A.G. Nagpur. Her pension case is submitted to the A.G. Office, Nagpur. As

per submission of the ld. counsel for the applicant there will be problem in getting pension. Moreover, nobody is posted in place of the applicant at Nagpur. Hence, he prayed to grant stay to the impugned order of transfer dtd.11/11/2022.

4. Heard Shri S. Deo, ld. C.P.O. for the Respondent No.1. He has strongly opposed the prayer of the ld. counsel for the applicant and submitted that it is the discretion of the Govt. for extension of the tenure as per Section 5 of the Transfer Ac,2005.

5. As per Section 5 of the Transfer Act,2005, the employee who is due for retirement within one year, the tenure can be extended. The applicant is working at Nagpur since 21/12/2020. Her normal tenure comes to end on 21/12/2023. She is due for retirement on 30/06/2023. Therefore, it is clear that she has not completed her normal tenure at Nagpur. Her pension case is submitted to the A.G. Office, Nagpur. Nobody is posted in her place. Looking to the submission, the impugned order of transfer dtd.11/11/2022 is hereby stayed until further order so far as the applicant is concerned.
