Learned counsel for the applicant has pointed out Section 5 of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (in short "Transfers Act,2005"). As per the Section 5 of the Transfers Act, 2005, the tenure of posting of the Government servant or employee may be extended, in case of employee is due for transfer after completion of tenure at a station of posting or post has less than one year for retirement. The applicant is about to retire within six months.
- 4. In view of the section 5 of the Transfers Act, 2005, the respondents to consider the representation of the applicant. As per the submission of learned counsel for the applicant, he is not relieved. **Hence, the impugned transfer is stayed till filing of reply.**
- 5. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable **on 04.05.2023**. Learned C.P.O. waives notice for State. Hamdast allowed.
- 6. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.
- 7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

8. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
