2. The ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that the O.A. has become infructuous on account of retirement of the applicant on 30.06.2020.

3. In view of this statement, the O.A. is disposed of with no order as to costs.

2. By this C.A. the applicant is seeking stay to effect and implementation of order dated 09.09.2022 (A-7).

3. Contention of the applicant has set out in para no. 3 of the C.A. is as follows:-

"That, the applicant has given detail reply to all the notices, how the recovery is not correct against the applicant as per the rules and procedure and manual of Godown Keeping. That, as per Godown Manual Chapter-7 of the Manual for shortage in stored food grain para-7.1 provides the reasons for reduction in the stock of food grains, it also provides classification of losses in four categories. The para No.7.2 provides for transit loss, para No.7.3 provides godown losses and as per 7.3.2 the officers can rights of loss and it provides that the losses less than 1% for every three month storage can be considered as a reasonable loss. At the time of inspection and passing the order this facts are not taking into consideration by respondents therefore, the order for recovery is arbitrary."

4. To support aforequoted contentions the applicant has relied on the judgment dated 17.01.2019 delivered by Aurangabad Bench of this Tribunal in O.A.No. 04/2017. In this Judgment following observations are made:-

"8. The Government Resolution dated 1.04.2008 provides that loss to the extent of 2% has to be considered reasonable for the food-grain stored in the amount, during the year 2004-2005 to 2006-2007. Neither the Applicant nor

the Respondents has produced the recent G.R. issued by the Government in that regard.

9. On going through the above said referred provision of Godown Manual as well as G.R., it reveals that the Government can write off the loss caused in the stock of food-grain due to storage in the Godown for long period to the certain extent and limit fixed by the Government in that regard, has to be considered 'reasonable'. If the loss is more than reasonable percentage of loss prescribed by the Government, then the excess loss shall be recovered by the concerned officer at the rate of Rs.1.5 % of the basis price."

The applicant has further relied on order dated 28.02.2023 in which *inter alia* it is stated:-

"4 १०० टक्के पडताळणी असल्यामुळे प्रत्येक थप्पीतील १०% धान्याचे प्रत्यक्ष वजन करून तफावत १% च्या वर जर असली तर १००% गोदामाची मोजनी करावी व वजन पट्टीचे उतारे घेवून त्यानुसार अहवाल सादर करावा. "

Having regard to facts of the case, contentions of the applicant, judgment dated 17.01.2019 and order dated 28.02.2023 case is made out to stay the effect and implementation of order dated 09.09.2022 (A-7) till further orders. Effect and implementation of order dated 09.09.2022 (A-7) is stayed till further orders.
