- 3. The applicant has challenged the impugned order dated 09.10.2019 and 04.07.2022. The applicant was prosecuted for the offence punishable under Section 376(2)(i) and 376(2)(j) under the POSCO Act. The respondents without conducting any enquiry dismissed the applicant as per the provision of Article 311 (2) (b) of Constitution of India. The ld. counsel for the applicant has pointed out the order passed by this Tribunal in O.A. No. 396/2022 dated 06.06.2022. He has also pointed out the Judgment of Special Court, Amravati dated 08.03.2022 in Special Case No. 281/2019.
- 4. The applicant is already acquitted by Special Court, Amravati in Special Case No. 281/2019 as per Judgment dated 08.03.2022. The Article 311 (2) (b) reads as under:
 - "311. Dismissal, removal or reduction in rank of persons employed in civil capacities under the Union or a state (1) No person who is a member of civil service of the Union or an all-India service or a civil service of a State or holds civil post under the Union or a State shall be dismissed or removed by an authority subordinate to that by which he was appointed.
 - (2) No such person as aforesaid shall be dismissed or removed or reduced in rank except after an inquiry in which he has been informed of the charges against him and given a reasonable opportunity of being heard in respect of those charges.

Provided that where it is proposed after such inquiry, to impose upon him any such penalty, such penalty may be imposed on the basis of the evidence adduced during such inquiry and it shall not be necessary to give such person any opportunity of making representation on the penalty proposed;

Provided further that this clause shall not apply -

- (a) Where a person is dismissed or removed or reduced in rank on the ground of conduct which has led to his conviction on a criminal charge; or
- (b) Where the authority empowered to dismiss or remove a person or to reduce him in rank is satisfied that for some reason, to be recorded by that authority in writing, it is not reasonably practicable to hold such inquiry."
- 5. On this issue many Judgments have been delivered by this Tribunal and Hon'ble Apex Court that without holding any enquiry the dismissal from service as per Article 311 (2) (b) is not proper, it is also decided by this Tribunal in O.A. No. 396/2022 and other O.As.
- 6. In view of this situation, **the impugned order dated 09.10.2019 (A-1, Pg. No. 19) and 04.07.2022 (A-2, Pg. No. 21) are hereby quashed and set aside.** The respective Appointing Authorities are directed to reinstate the applicant in service within a period of 30 days from the date of this order. 50% back wages be paid to the applicant till he joins. The respondents are at liberty to conduct preliminary inquiry as per Maharashtra Civil Services (Disciplinary & Appeal) Rules, 1979 against the applicant and take appropriate action as per the law.

The applicant is transferred from his original post Jawhar (District Thane) to Amravati District in the year 2006. Therefore, his seniority is rightly counted from 11.08.2006. Hence, the seniority of respondent no. 4 is from dated 31.12.2002 and seniority of applicant is from dated 11.08.2006. Therefore, it is clear that applicant is junior to respondent no. 4 moreover as per the decision of D.P.C.

meeting dated 29.09.2008 the post of Chief Accountant was reserved for N.T. (B). Though, the respondent no. 4 is in the category of N.T. (B). Therefore, the respondent no. 4 is rightly promoted on the post of Chief Accountant. Hence, we do not find any merit in the original application, therefore, we proceed to pass the following order:-

P.O. has submitted that the final inquiry report is submitted to the disciplinary authority and only the order of punishment is to be passed. As per the M.C.S. (Discipline and Appeal) Rule, 1979, once the inquiry officer submits final report, thereafter disciplinary authority has to issue show cause notice to the delinquent thereafter delinquent may submit explanation thereafter disciplinary authority has to pass proper order.
- 4. In the present O.A., the final report of inquiry officer is already submitted to the disciplinary authority and now it is pending before the respondent no. 2. The aplicant is at liberty to make submission before the disciplinary authority with his defence. Once the departmental inquiry is completed the Tribunal cannot quash and set aside the inquiry.

5. Hence, O.A. is disposed of with no order as to costs with direction to respondent no. 2 to take decision on the final report of the inquiry officer within a period of two months from the date of this order.

- 2. The applicant has been working as Chief Officer, Daryapur Municipal Council, District Amravati since 8.9.2021 (Annexure A-1).
- 3. Order dated 05.09.2022 at Annexure A-2 (page 11) transferring respondent no.2 to the post presently held by the applicant is impugned in this 0.A.
- 4. The applicant has categorically pleaded that respondent no.2 is being accommodated on the post of Chief Officer at Daryapur, Municipal Council on recommendation of M.L.A. Shri. Prakash Bharsakale. Further statement made on behalf of the applicant is that he is still continuing on his post at Daryapur and he has not been relieved.
- 5. It is also submitted that respondent no.2, so far i.e. till 3.20 pm has not joined on the post of Chief Officer at Daryapur Municipal Council.
- 6. The applicant has relied on the following stipulation in G.R. dated 11.02.2015.

एखाद्या अधिकारी/कर्मचा-याने एखाद्या विशिष्ट पदाची मागणी केल्यास वा सदरहू अधिकारी/कर्मचा-याने मा. लोकप्रतिनिधी मार्फत एखाद्या विशिष्ट पदाची मागणी केल्यास व सदरहू विशिष्ट पदावर ३ वर्षापेक्षा कमी कालावधी असलेला अधिकारी/कर्मचारी कार्यरत असल्यास संबंधित अधिकारी /कर्मचा-याची बदली न करता मागणी करणा-या अधिकारी/कर्मचा-याची बदली न करता मागणी करणा-या अधिकारी/कर्मचा-याची पदस्थापना अन्य पदावर करण्याची दक्षता बदली प्राधिका-याने घ्यावी.

- 7. On the basis of aforestated contentions the applicant is praying for appropriate interim relief.
- 8. In reply it is submitted by learned C.P.O. that in the impugned order it is specifically mentioned that Sub-Sections 4 and 5 of Section 4 of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 have been complied with and therefore, prima facie, there appears to be no substance in any of the contentions raised by the applicant.
- 9. It is further submitted by the C.P.O. that mere pleading of the applicant that respondent no.2 is being accommodated at Daryapur on recommendation of M.L.A. Shri. Prakash Bharsakale will not suffice to establish correctness of said contention.

10. On considering rival submissions and record of the case I have come to the conclusion that

a case is made out to grant interim relief by passing an order of status-quo. Hence, the order.

ORDER

Status-quo shall be maintained till the returnable date.

11. Issue notice to Respondent no.2, returnable after two weeks. Learned C.P.O. waives notice for

respondent no.1. Hamdast allowed.

12. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal

shall not be issued.

13. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of

hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to

notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

14. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal

(Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

15. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained

and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to

file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

16. In case notice is not collected within **three days** and if service report on affidavit is not filed **three**

days before returnable date. Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal

and papers be consigned to record.
