- 2. The applicant has challenged the transfer order dated 23/08/2023 (P-10) by which she is transferred from the post of District Sports Officer, Yavatmal to the post of District Sports Officer, Gondia. The applicant has challenged this order on the ground that it is a premature transfer. As per the Section 4 of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (in short "Transfers Act,2005"), it is a illegal transfer. Hence, the impugned transfer order is liable to be quashed and set aside.
- 3. The respondent nos.1 to 3 have filed their reply. Along with the reply, the document / letter dated 10/04/2018 (P-42) is filed on record which shows that the applicant was arrested for the offence punishable under the prevention of Corruption Act. She was put under suspension. As per the order of this Tribunal, the suspension was revoked.
- 4. During the course of submission, the learned counsel for the applicant has pointed out the following Judgments –

- 5. The facts in the cited Judgments are very much different. During the course of submission, the learned P.O. has pointed out the approval for transfer given by the Chief Minister (State of Maharashtra). It is taken on record and marked Exh-X for identification. As per the provisions of Section 4 (5) of the Transfers Act,2005, the condition for premature transfer is fulfilled by the respondents. Hence, the impugned transfer order cannot be said to be illegal.
- 6. The learned P.O. has submitted that the applicant was already relieved, but mislead this Court and therefore the interim relief was granted.
- 7. It is clear from the order of the Chief Minister (State of Maharashtra), the transfer was made from Yavatmal to Gondia. Therefore, there is a compliance of Section 4 (5) of the Transfers Act, 2005. Hence, the applicant is not entitled for relief. Hence, the following order is passed –

- (i) The O.A. is dismissed.
- (ii) No order as to costs.
