He has also filed the typed copy of the Gazette of India Notification dated 02.12.1985 in which according to him at Sr.No.46 Sarkhani village appears and further he has also pointed out the documents at page no.222, Annexure A-31 where it is bifurcated by Sarkhani to Salaiguda. However, the Notification filed by the respondents at Sr.No.46 there was some other village appears. On Sr.No.46 their substitution is not produced properly and name of village appears to be different.
- 3. In view of this discrepancy ld. P.O. is directed to take following instructions from the Additional Tribal Commissioner Nagpur or the Tribal Commissioner Amravati.
- 1] Whether Kinwat Taluka is covered under the scheduled area or not?
- 2] Whether bifurcation of villages is as per 1985 Notification of Scheduled Area/Tribal area or not?
- 3] Whether list of villages which has been notify under PESA or not?

These three documents are required to be filed.

- 4. Learned P.O. is directed to file reply in two weeks.
- 5. **S.O. two weeks.**
- 6. **Steno copy is granted.**
