2. The applicant, an Executive Engineer came to be transferred vide order dated 7.12.2016 (A.2 P.19) from Wardha to Yavatmal. The challenge is twofold.. It is mid-tenure and mid-term transfer. The applicant is working on the present post at Wardha from 5.11.2015 and he was not due for transfer. It is a mid-tenure transfer. The order is issued on 7.12.2016. Thus, it is a mid-term. As such compliance of section 4 (4) & 4 (5) of the Act is necessary.

The impugned order mentions that it is issued after complying the provisions of Section 4 (5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as,

- "Transfer Act"). However, order is completely silent about the compliance of Section 4 (4) (ii) of the Act.
- 3. The learned P.O. submits that the applicant and respondent No.3 are working under Vidarbha Irrigation Development Corporation and the State is not made party. However, the formalities can be completed. The order is issued by the Government and the applicant and respondent No.3 are Govt. servants and in effect, such technical ground cannot stand as a hurdle in the way.
- 4. Needless to mention that if the order is mid-term and mid-tenure, the compliance of Section 4 (4) and 4 (5) of the Act is to be done. Even if the order is taken as it is, it mentions that there is compliance of the provisions of Section 4 (5) of the Act only. On the face of it, it appears that there is no compliance of Section 4 (4) of the Act. When the applicant was not due for transfer and the order is issued mid-term, compliance of Section 4 (4) of the Act is also necessary.

- 5. The learned P.O. submits that vide earlier order dated 5.11.2015, the applicant was posted on promotion. Needless to mention that it is also transfer within the meaning of the Act.
- 6. The learned P.O. also submits that in the impugned order, there is a mention that the order is issued under the provisions of the Transfer Act. However. when the department is specific enough to quote the compliance of the provisions of section 4 (5) of the Transfer Act, one fails to understand that why the compliance of Section 4 (4) of the Act is not mentioned and, therefore, it cannot be taken that it is not in compliance of the provisions of Section 4 (4) of the Act."

It is also contended by the learned counsel for the applicant that respondent No.3 is transferred thrice in one year i.e. in June 2015, August 2015 and December 2015 and he did not join his place of posting and now at his instance, the impugned order is passed. All these aspects can be considered after giving an opportunity

to the other side. But fact remains that the applicant is subjected to transfer under the provisions of the Transfer Act with complying the provisions of Section 4 (4) of the Act. The learned counsel for the applicant also relied on the observations made in O.A. Nos. 992 and 994 of 2016 in the order dated 13.10.2016 pending before the Principal Bench of this Tribunal at Mumbai that the compliance of both sections is necessary. That being the legal position, interim stay is granted in that case.

- 7. In the above state of affairs, impugned order dated 7.12.2016 is stayed till reply is filed by the respondents.
- 8. Issue notice before admission to R. 2 and 3 returnable <u>after two</u> weeks.
- 9. Smt. S.V. Kolhe,learned P.O. waives notice for respondent No.1. Hamdast granted.
- 10. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and

separate notice for final disposal need not be issued.

- 11. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A
- 12. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunals (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.
