However for one reason or other the appointment process was not completed. Thereafter, fresh notification in 2015 is issued for appointment of Police Patil reserving the post for Open category which is under challenge.

3. The learned P.O. submits that the with the passage of time, the earlier reservation now lapses. However, the learned counsel for the applicant contends contrary and want to take the recourse of citation.
