2. The applicant has grievances about difference in calculation of amount related to pending bills of increment and salary between the period from 1/7/2010 to 30/4/2014 as per correspondence dated 28/5/2020 (A-6,P-21) made by the District Health Officer, Bhandara the difference was calculated to the tune of Rs.14,40,539/-. However, subsequently as per letter dated 5/3/2021 (Exh-X) written to Deputy Director, Public Health Nagpur Circle, Nagpur by the Joint Director, Health Services, Mumbai this pending/ outstanding related to the salary and increment between 1/7/2010 to 30/4/2014 has been communicated as Rs.10,11,486/-. The applicant feels injustice about this reduction in calculation of amount. However, as pointed out by the learned P.O., the calculation is made by the A.G. However, no document from the A.G. Office filed on record. In this situation, either P.O. should file document which has been communicated by the A.G. to the Department or the applicant should make A.G. as respondent.

Alternatively, applicant may get calculation sheet from the A.G. Officer under the RTI Act.

3. In order dated 9/3/2021 it has been mentioned that a special person Shri C. Chandrashekhar Fedvevar, Peon was deputed by the Deputy Director of Health Department, Nagpur (vide letter dated 5/3/202, P-38 filed by the P.O.) to go to Mumbai and take the documents from Commionerate, Mumbai and submit the same to the Director (Health Services-2), Pune Office. The learned P.O. is not aware about further progress of this action. As submitted by the learned P.O. the matter be kept on the next date of hearing for submitting progress report.

Chavan and this noting of Desk Officer has been overruled by the Deputy Secretary Shri Kulkarni and he has made following noting —
