In the recruitment process 100% are from direct recruitment and they do not have power drawing and disturbsment. They worked under Head Master of Ashram School and Head Master is treated as Head of the Institution.

4. In view of these differences the Superintendent post cannot be compared with Warden post

5. In view of discussion in above paras, relief sought in para-7 on page no.7 of O.As. do not have any legal backing.
