It is submitted that the order of statusquo dated 11.01.2023 was obtained by suppressing that request of the applicant for modification of her transfer order was rejected. Learned counsel for the respondent no.5 is seeking vacation of interim order of status-quo dated 11.01.2023. Today learned counsel for the applicant is absent.

3. It would be open to respondent no.5 to make submission for vacation of interim order dated 11.01.2023 on the returnable date i.e. 30.01.2023.
