This MA is moved by the respondents in the OA seeking extension of time to comply with our order dated 4.1.2016.</p> <p>3. In the first place the concluding and operative part of our order dated 4.1.2016 in fact needs to be fully reproduced for ready reference:</p> <p>“7. Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, the Respondents are directed to consider the claim of the Applicant for deemed date of promotion to the post of S.P. (M.T.) when a vacancy of SP (MT) arose in the promotion quota in the year 2007 within a period of 3 months from the date of this order. If the Applicant is found eligible for the deemed date of promotion from any date between 2007 to 2010, he may be considered for promotion to the post of DIG (MT) within a further period of one month. Otherwise, he may be considered for promotion in the</p>

normal course and in any case on or before 30.6.2016. The Original Application is disposed of accordingly with no order as to costs."

4. Nothing more needs to be said or done and the said para is self explanatory. Thereby regard being had to the requirements for compliance much more sufficient time was given. Therefore, for all the details set out in the MA probably trying to indicate as to what steps were taken we remain unimpressed by <sup>the</sup> craving for more time. After all a litigant moves the judicial forum for redressal of the grievances and if he is found entitled thereto no doubt some time is required to be given for compliance but an unusually long time for compliance would ultimately lead to failure of justice. We find absolutely no justification in extending the time for compliance. This MA is, therefore, dismissed with no order as to costs.
