ORDER


The Applicants who have brought these two Original Applications hereby seek condonation of delay which they have quantified as 127 days.

- We have perused the record and proceedings and heard Shri A.A. Desai, the learned Advocate for the Applicants. Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents 1 to 4 and Smt. Punam Mahaian. the learned Advocate for Respondents 5 & 9. The other Respondents are served but are neither present nor represented.
- The point is as to whether the delay, "if any" needs to be condoned and our finding thereon is in the affirmative for the following reasons.
- We make it very clear that we are severely restricting ourselves to this application for condonation of delay and we are not going to consider at all any fact relevant either to the RA or even the OA. This much needs to be said, however, that by the order made by this Bench in the two OAs detailed above, the appointments to the Respondents 4 to 27 in OA 289/2015 and Respondents 5 to 19 in OA 620/2015 were quashed and set aside and the MPSC was directed to prepare a revised merit list and to fill up the posts horizontally reserved merit list in the manner therein indicated. Now, according to the Applicants, it was



on 26th February, 2016 that the 3rd Respondent published the revised merit list which has affected them and Mr. Desai, the learned Advocate apprehended that the Applicants may end up losing the posts. It was thereafter that the matter was carried to the Hon'ble High Court by way of Writ Petition No.3308/2016 (Sandeep B. Pawar & ors. Vs. The State of Maharashtra & ors.). The Division Bench of the Hon'ble the Chief Justice by the order of 17th March, 2016 dismissed the said Writ Petition as withdrawn at the request of the learned Advocate for the Petitioners with liberty to approach the appropriate forum. It is thereafter that on 29th February, 2016.

- 5. The learned P.O. told us that the time will begin to run from the date of the order in the OAs, and therefore, the delay is not just 127 days or whatever. Without prejudice to her rights to assail the case of the Applicants in the R.A, the delay was condoned. Smt. Mahajan, the learned Advocate for the two private Respondents opposed this MA.
- The facts hereinabove discussed, would make it quite clear that for the reasons which we need not discuss in this order or whatever the Applicants were not the parties to the OAs and as far as they are concerned, we



tend to agree with Mr. Desai that the cause of action would arise on the day the revised merit list was published. Thereafter, the matter was carried to the Hon'ble High Court and then ultimately after the withdrawal of the Writ Petition, the present proceedings were initiated. Now, even if there is a delay and this is an assumption still on the sufficiency of cause aspect of the matter, a case for condonation is anyhow made out. In such applications, the judicial forum does not just act on the existence of delay but as to whether there is cause for condonation thereof and we are so disposed as to conclude for the Applicants in that behalf.

The Misc. Application is hereby allowed. The delay is condoned. The Applicants and the Office are directed to process the application for review, so as to be placed for regular hearing. No order as to costs hereof.
