This MA brought by the ori. Respondent-State for getting interim order dated 27.3.2017 vacated whereby the order impugned in the OA referring the Applicant from Pune to Bhandara has been challenged. Misc. Applicants themselves in Para 5 mentioned the fact that the file related to the approval by the Hon'ble Minister had not been produced and the interim order was passed. In my opinion, now that the OA can be heard on merit as an expedited one after the Affidavit-in-Rejoinder is filed. It is not necessary to interfere with the interim order already made. It is directed that the Affidavit-in-rejoinder must be filed on the next date and the OA shall be taken up for final hearing as an expedited one, after one week thereafter. Interim order continues till further order. M.A. is accordingly disposed of with no order as to costs.
