## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. These M.As are filed for condonation of delay of one year and nine months and to modify the order dated 09.03.2022 whereby 9% interest was granted to the Applicants.
- 2. Heard Smt. K.S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Applicants (Original Respondents) and Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Respondents (Original Applicants).
- 3. The perusal of record reveals that the O.A. No.1158/2016 was decided with O.A. No.352/2017 and O.A. No.353/2017 by common judgment dated 09.03.2020. These O.As. were filed by employees of Dairy Development Department against the order of recovery and downgrading of pay and pension. The Applicants retired from Government services in between 2006 & 2015 but their retiral benefits were withheld, and they were constrained to file Original Applications

before this Tribunal. The perusal of judgment dated 09.03.2022 passed by the Tribunal reveals that after retirement the Government in view of objection of pay verification unit downgraded pay scale of the Applicants affecting their pension. Tribunal held that the Applicants were entitled to the pay scale which they were rightly getting at the time of retirement. As such it was not the case pertaining to recovery of alleged excess payment but it was of downgrading of pay scale which there were rightly getting at the time of retirement. The Tribunal therefore quashed order of recovery and directed to release retrial benefits with consequential service benefits within three months. The Applicants have been retired long back, and therefore directions were given to refund amount of recovery from them within three months from the date of order and failing which amount shall carry interest at the rate of 9% from the date of order till actual payment.

- 4. Now M.As are filed to waive the order of grant of 9% interest on the amount to be refunded.
- 5. Learned P.O. submits that amount is already refunded to the Applicants which is not disputed by learned Advocate for the Applicant.
- 6. Now question remains whether the order of interest can be waived as claimed in M.A.
- 7. Learned P.O. submits that due to COVID-19 surge and Pandemic situation M.A. cannot be filed within one month and secondly since amount is already paid tax liability should be waived.
- 8. Per Contra, Shri A.V. Bandiwadekar, learned Advocate for the Applicants submits that the Respondents have not complied with the order passed by the Tribunal and was constrained to file C.A. No.19/2020 which is still pending before Division Bench. According to him even in C.A. Respondents took time of nearly two years to comply

the order passed by the Tribunal with the assurance that Respondents are complying the order.

- 9. Admittedly, the judgment dated 09.03.2020 had attended finality since it is not challenged before Hon'ble High Court.
- 10. Insofar as interest part is concerned Tribunal has granted interest considering hardship faced by the Applicants for long time. Indeed, the Tribunal has granted three months time to refund the amount and it is only in case of failure to refund the amount within three months interest was to be paid at the rate of 9% from the date of order till actual payment.
- 11. Indeed the interest was granted on the amount to which the Applicants were legally entitled but it was recovered from them and utilized by the Respondents. It is in that context and situation Tribunal has granted 9% interest if amount is not refunded within three months. As such, the Tribunal has given enough time of three months to refund the amount but it was not paid within three months and the Applicants were constrained to file C.A. No such application for extension of time for the compliance of order is filed before this Tribunal.
- 12. These M.As to waive interest are now filed after nearly two years from the date of order. Since, the Applicants were entitled to the amount wrongly recovered from them Respondents cannot escape their liability to pay the same with interest since it is not paid within three months as directed by the Tribunal.
- 13. Basically it was for Respondents to demonstrate how the order of interest is incorrect so that it could be waived. However, in this behalf nothing is forthcoming, this being the position, order passed by the Tribunal it cannot be modified in such a manner by filing M.A. This

M.A. is nothing but attempt to deprive retired Government servant of

their legitimate dues.

14. Indeed, as pointed out by learned Advocate for the Applicants as

seen from the record General Manager, Greater Mumbai by his letter

dated 02.02.2021 requested C.P.O. to file M.A. to waive condition of

interest. However, no such steps were taken in pursuance of the letter

dated 02.02.2021 within reasonable time. It is on 16.03.2022 after

nearly about one year from the date of letter of General Manager,

Worli Dairy, present M.A. is filed.

15. Notably, learned Advocate for the Applicant has tendered letter

dated 08.03.2022 issued by the Government addressed to The

Commissioner, Dairy Development Department giving direction to fix

responsibility upon the concerned for delay and payment of interest to

the Applicants. Thus it appears that at one hand the Government is

directing the Commissioner, Dairy Development Department to fix the

responsibility for payment of interest and on the other hand General

Manager, Worli Dairy instead of complying the said order has filed

present M.A. to waive the interest.

16. In view of above, judicial order cannot be modified by filing such

belated M.A. without challenging it before Higher forum or without filing

review which is again subject to constrains of order 47 Rule 1 of C.P.C.

This is nothing but abuse of process of law. M.A for waving interest is

not at all maintainable and is liable to be dismissed.

17. Accordingly both the M.As are dismissed with no order as to costs.
