Heard Shri D.B Khaire learned advocate for the applicant and Smt Kranti S. Gaikwad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

This Misc Application has been filed seeking the relief that the Respondents may be directed to ensure that the body which has sought the services of the Applicant on deputation is made to pay his salary. It appears that the Applicant has been posted with Pune District Urban Cooperative Banks Association, Pune on deputation. He was transferred from that post to some other post which he has challenged in the Original Application, and interim relief has been granted to him. However, the said Association has not paid the salary of the Applicant. In such cases, in my opinion, the Respondents should take very serious view of the matter and decide not to post any Government officer to such Association. It is also moral and legal responsibility of the Respondents to ensure that as long as the Applicant is working on that post, the Association is made to pay his salary.

On instructions from Shri Nitin Gaikwad, Under Secretary, Cooperation, Textile & Marketing Department, learned Presenting Officer states that efforts will be made to ensure that all the back wages of the Applicant will be paid within a period of two weeks.

Misc Application stands disposed of accordingly with no order as to costs.
