**ORDER**

1. Heard Shri B.A Bandiwadekar, learned advocate for the Applicant and Ms Neelima Gohad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

2. The applicant has made following prayer:-

“9(a) By a suitable order/direction, this Hon’ble Tribunal may be pleased to set aside the impugned order dated 28.5.2019 passed by the Respondent no. 1 (Exh. A) under which he treated the post of the Assistant Commissioner, Animal Husbandry to be isolated post and accordingly the Petitioner is granted the additional grade pay of isolated post as the first benefit of Time Bound Promotion

and not in the pay band of Rs. 15600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5700/- attached to the said post and accordingly the petitioner be granted all the consequential service benefits, as if the impugned order was not passed.”

3. During hearing, learned advocate for the applicant on instructions from the applicant, who is present, submitted that he was in correspondence with the Respondents prior to the issuance of the order dated 28.5.2019. He submits that he proposed to make further representation in this regard following the order on 28.5.2019. He seeks that the Respondents may be directed to decide his representation expeditiously.

4. Learned P.O submits that once the representation is made, the concerned Respondents would be instructed to ensure that the representation is decided on merits expeditiously.

5. In view of the foregoing, the Respondents, if they receive the representation made by the applicant, are directed to look into the same and decide it within a period of 3 months on merits after recording reasons.

6. Original Application stands disposed off accordingly. No order as to costs.
