- 2. This OA can be disposed off at this stage itself finally. In that connection a reference could be had to an order dated 13.4.2016 made by one of us sitting in the SB (Shri R.B. Malik) dated 13.4.2016.
- 3. It is not necessary to set out the facts in great detail. It would be suffice to mention that the disciplinary authority has held the applicant guilty and has imposed the punishment of 10% reduction in the pension permanently. The appeal there against has been preferred before the competent appellate authority on 15.10.2015 and the same is still pending. The applicant in the OA itself seeks directions that the said appeal be decided within four weeks from the order that the Tribunal would make.
- 4. Ld. PO on instructions from Smt. M.V. Shiwalkar, Assistant, Food and Civil Supplies Department, informs that the matter was appointed for hearing on 30.4.2016 and on one occasion it was required to be adjourned on the request of the applicant. We make it clear that no party including

the applicant should not be needlessly protracting the mater by seeking adjournment. We are laying down the outer time limit with due regard to the facts and circumstances and therefore the said time limit must be adhered to.

5. This OA stands disposed off with a direction to the respondent the appellate authority to finally decide the appeal of the applicant pending before him on or before 30.6.2016 and communicate its outcome to the applicant within one week thereof. No order as to costs.
