It would be suffice to mention that the disciplinary authority has held the applicant guilty and has imposed the punishment of 10% reduction in the pension permanently. The appeal there against has been preferred before the competent appellate authority on 15.10.2015 and the same is still pending. The applicant in the OA itself seeks directions that the said appeal be decided within four weeks from the order that the Tribunal would make.</p> <p>4. Ld. PO on instructions from Smt. M.V. Shiwalkar, Assistant, Food and Civil Supplies Department, informs that the matter was appointed for hearing on 30.4.2016 and on one occasion it was required to be adjourned on the request of the applicant.
