In this OA, the applicant has sought a limited relief for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider his representation dated 2.11.2012 and take a decision on the same as per rules in respect of the period from 18.9.2007 to 31.5.2010 when he was under suspension consequent to registration of an offence under Section 7, 13(1) and (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act. Smt. Gohad has no objection to prescribe a time frame for decision in the matter by the respondents.
