The OA is brought by a Clerk-cum-Typist in the office of Respondent No.2 who has suffered an order of compulsory retirement at the culmination of the departmental enquiry. He preferred and appeal against the said order of the disciplinary authority, The memo of appeal was lodged on 26th December, 2013 although the 1st acknowledgement was issued only on 15th May, 2014. Ever since then, the appeal has remained pending and that being the state of affairs, even as the Respondents would oppose the grant of any relief, I am of the opinion that the only fair course of action would be to direct the final decision of the appeal within eight weeks from today, which is a sufficient time considering the fact that the appeal has remained pending for more than two years already. No other relief is being granted herein, but it is made clear that if the circumstances so demand, the Applicant's right to re-agitate any point other than the one herein involved is intact.
