## O.A. No.909 of 2015

Heard Shri V.P. Potbhare, learned Advocate holding for Shri A.S. Deshpande, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Miss Neelima Gohad, learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

This OA is disposed off on 29.1.2016. The 21 deponent of the affidavit in reply dated 4.12.2015 in the disposed off OA No.909 of 2015, Smt. Mridula Shnieey Deshpande, Under Secretary, Public Works Department is present. She tenders an affidavit dated 12.2016 in deference to our order in the OA. Shri N.K. Rajpurohit, the Ld. CPO, who had drafted that al'fidavit is not present. Miss Gohad, Ld. PO is holding for him. The affidavit filed today expectedly attributes a major lapse in the affidavit in reply to mistake and such other expressions are used. The thereof Smt. Deshpande tenders deponent unconditional apology which she has already shown in the affidavit also. Regardless of whatever course of action we adopt we must record that the seriousness of the matter is not dawned on both the sides. The casualness is writ large in the affidavit in reply. We have already indicated in the order that the affidavits really are the evidence in such matters and on such an important piece of material elementary fact of which department the deponent was working in has been wrongly mentioned. If this mistake had not been detected then it would have further compounded the tragedy and the record would have given very poor view.
