Heard Shri S.S. Dere, the learned Advocate for the Applicant and Shri A.J. Chougule, the learned Presenting Officer for the Respondents.

This OA relates to the issue of promotion of the Applicant to the cadre of Health Equipment Maintenance Officer, Geneal State Services, Class-II (to be hereinafter called the said post).

In fact, a very detailed account of events is not necessary to be narrated. It appears to be an indisputable factual position that the Applicant has been longing for the said promotion eversince the year 2004. We are told at the Bar that the DPC has not been convened from 2004. This factual aspect is not in dispute and as a matter of fact, no other challenge is thrown at the maintainability of this OA for any reason whatsoever.

It is absolutely clear, therefore, that it can by no stretch of imagination be countenanced that the DPC should not have been convined for more than a decade. The averments in that behalf having been made in Para 11 of the OA have not been traversed at all in the Affidavit-in-

Although the prayer clause (c) inter-alia seeks deemed date of promotion from 2004, that relief cannot be granted now herein and that position in all fairness is again not disputed even by Mr. Dere, the learned Advocate for the Applicant. Therefore, regard being had to the inordinately long time taken even for convene DPC, we are of the opinion that appropriate time limit set down in disposing of this OA for the DPC to be convened and for considering the case of the Applicant for the promotion to the said post.

The present OA is allowed to the extent that the Respondents are hereby directed to convene the DPC for considering the promotion of the Applicant to the said post within a period of three months from today and convey to the Applicant the decision thereof within one week thereafter. No order as to costs.
