11. Hon'ble Shri P.W. Khair, the learned Advocate for the applicant, Mr A.L. Chougale, the Presenting Officer for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and Shri A.V. Karbhari, the learned Advocate for the Respondent No.4.

12. Learned P.O. for the Respondents states that so far he has not received instructions.

13. Learned Advocate for the Applicant states that if the protection granted to him is continued till the date of his retirement, the ends of justice will meet.

14. Learned Advocate for the Respondent No.4 has received instructions from Respondent No.4 who is present and states as follows:

That if the transfer order is implemented after applicant's retirement, he has no objection for disposal of O.A. by continuing the interim order till 31.3.2016 i.e. the date of Applicant's retirement.

15. In view of the foregoing, and in the background that so far the Government has not answered the O.A. and even has not moved for vacation of interim order, this O.A. can be disposed of by making interim order passed on 20.10.2015 as a rule of the Tribunal.
