ORAL ORDER:

- 1. Heard Ku. Anagha Pandit, learned Counsel holding for Talekar & Associates for the applicant and Shri M.S.Mahajan, learned Chief Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities
- 2. Present applicant had applied for her transfer to the post of Forest Guard from the post of Clerk-cum-Typist. According to the applicant such course is permissible and reliance is placed on the provision under Rule 27(1)(b) of the Maharashtra Civil Services (General Conditions of Service) Rule, 1981. Learned Counsel for applicant submits that, in so far as the candidates appointed on compassionate ground are concerned, the conditions as about the eligibility on physical grounds are relaxed. Applicant is continuously requesting for such transfer since 2018 and has time to time submitted the representations, however, the authorities concerned have not decided the said same.
- 3. In the affidavit in reply filed on behalf of respondent nos.1 to 4, in paragraph 6 it is stated that application of the applicant is forwarded by respondent no.4 to the respondent no.3 and it is pending for adjudication.

4. Having regard to the facts as aforesaid, without going

be disposed of with the following directions:

ORDER

[i] Respondent no.3 or whoever may be the

competent authority, shall take decision on the

representation submitted by the present

applicant within 8 weeks from the date of this

order and communicate the said decision to the

applicant.

[ii] Need not to state that, even thereafter if

grievance remains, it will be open for the

applicant to approach the Tribunal.

[iii] O.A. stands disposed of in the aforesaid

terms.

[iv] No order as to costs.
