## ORAL ORDER:

1. Heard Shri Ashish B. Rajkar, learned Counsel for the applicant and Shri V.R.Bhumkar, learned Presenting Officer for the respondent authorities.

- 2. Applicant is working on the post of Junior Clerk. Applicant got him transferred to Aurangabad region from Kolhapur region on request on the ground that his mother is seriously ailing and requires personal attention. Request of the applicant was considered. At the relevant time, it was communicated that respondent no.2 has consented for accepting the request of the applicant stating that he can be conveniently given posting in the RTO office at Aurangabad. However, after the region was changed, the applicant has been given posting at Beed. Before his posting at Beed, applicant had also made a written request for keeping him at Aurangabad on the grounds mentioned in his said representations, more particularly, about illness of his mother and his sister also.
- 3. Learned Counsel for the applicant pointed out that at the relevant time 5 posts were vacant at Aurangabad and he could have been accommodated against any one of such posts. Learned Counsel pointed out that the applicant has obeyed the order of posting and he has been working at Beed from last 8 months. It is the contention of the applicant that in view of the vacancies available at

Aurangabad, his case can be considered for his posting at

Aurangabad.

4. After having considered the submissions and after

having gone through the affidavit in reply filed on behalf of

the respondents, it appears that in the ensuing annual

general transfers case of the applicant can be conveniently

considered. Ordinarily, such transfers are made in April or

May and process starts sometime in March. Applicant

shall file a fresh representation and if such a

representation is filed the respondents shall consider it on

the grounds as are mentioned even in the earlier

representations and as are mentioned while seeking his

inter-region transfer from Kolhapur to Aurangabad region.

5. With the observations as above, O.A. stands disposed

of. No order as to costs.
