Heard Shri S.M. Bhangde, the learned counsel for the applicant and Shri A.M. Ghogre, the learned P.O. for the respondents.

2. This O.A. was tagged and listed on the board alongwith O.A. No.589/2012. O.A. No.589/2012 was heard and by an order dated 11.2.2013^{was} dismissed on merit. Shri S.M. Bhangde, the learned counsel for the applicant and the learned P.Os appearing for the respondents fairly state that the question raised in the present O.A. is the same which has been adjudicated and answered in O.A.
