JUDGMENT

Heard Shri N.R.Saboo, learned counsel for the applicants and
Shri A.M.Ghogre, learned P.O. for the Respondents.

2. The cases of the applicants are that they were working as a Vanmazoor. They are eligible for regularization / absorption as per the G.R. of 2012 issued by the State of Maharashtra dated 16.10.2012. Earlier to this G.R., one G.R. was issued in the year 1996 for regularization of Vanmazoors. The some Vanmazoors were not eligible as per the G.R. of 1996 and, therefore, the Government of Maharashtra issued G.R. on 16.10.2012. The following conditions were given in the G.R. for absorption in the regular service which are below:-

3. As per G.Rs., Vanmazoors were working continuously from 01.11.1994 to 30.06.2004 are to be absorbed in the regular service on aforequoted conditions given in the G.R..

4. It is submitted that the respondents i.e. forest department had not considered regular services of the applicants as a Vanmazoor. They have completed five years regular services in the forest department as a Vanmazoor but they were not considered. List of all the applicants were submitted by Conservator of Forest, Yavatmal to the PCCF (Principal Chief

Conservator of Forest), Nagpur. After submitting the list, G.R. of 2012 was issued.

5. It is submitted that wrongly the Conservator of Forest shown all the applicants were working on E.G.S. (Employment Guarantee Scheme) and, therefore, they are not considered by the respondents for regularization.

6. It is submitted that all the applicants are entitled for absorption in the service as per Government regularization dated 16.10.2012.

7. All the O.As. are strongly opposed by the respondents. It is submitted that the applicants were working on E.G.S. and there is a condition in the Government Resolution dated 16.10.2012 that those Vanmazoors who were working on E.G.S. are not entitled for absorption in the service. It is submitted that the respondents have rightly decided their claim. They are not entitled for absorption as per the Government Resolution dated 16.10.2012. Hence, all the O.As. are liable to be dismissed.

8. Heard Advocate Shri N.R.Saboo, learned counsel for the applicants submitted that there was no enquiry by the respondents as to whether the applicants were working there on E.G.S.. As per the E.G.S., the names are to be submitted by Tehsildar to the concerned department. There is nothing on record to show that the applicants were appointed as a Vanmazoor as per E.G.S.. Learned counsel for the applicants has pointed out the following judgment which is below:-

One of the judgment is delivered by this Bench in O.A.No.134/2019.

The operative part of the judgment reads as under-

- i) The O.As. are partly allowed.***
- ii) The respondents are directed to consider the cases of all the applicants / legal heirs carefully and decide as to whether they are entitled for regularization as per G.R. dated 16/10/2012.***
- iii. C.As. are also disposed of.***
- iv. No order as to costs.***

9. The learned P.O., Shri A.M.Ghogre submits that in the same light the O.As. be decided.

10. The learned Advocate Shri N.R.Saboo has pointed out judgment in Writ Petition Nos. 5058/2008 and 5059/2008 and submits that the respondents have not conducted any inquiry in respect of the work of applicants on E.G.S.. Therefore, it was held that decision of the Industrial Court was justified for issuing directions to bring the Vanmazoor on C.R.T.E..

The learned counsel for the applicants has also pointed out the judgment in O.A.No.290/2013 and submits that the applicants be absorbed in the regular service as per G.R. of 2012.

11. Prior to the G.R. of 2012, the Government of Maharashtra called information from the concerned Forest Department as to how many Vanmazoors are working in the Forest Department. List of all the applicants were submitted stating that they were working as a Vanmazoor for a continuous period of more than five years and they have worked 240 days in each year. It was also submitted in the list that they were working on E.G.S.. After collecting all the informations, the Government of Maharashtra has issued G.R. of 16.10.2012 for regularization / absorption of 6546 Vanmazoors.

12. All the applicants are not absorbed by the Government of Maharashtra only because they were shown working on E.G.S.. There is one condition in the G.R. dated 16.10.2012 that the Vanmazoors who were working on E.G.S. are not eligible for absorption. The learned Advocate Shri N.R.Saboo has submitted that there is nothing on record to show that all the applicants were working on E.G.S..

13. This Tribunal has remanded the matters of similarly situated Vanmazoors with directions to the respondents to consider the cases of all the applicants / legal heirs carefully and decide as to whether they are entitled for regularization as per G.R. dated 16.10.2012. The Judgment of this Tribunal in O.A.No.134/2019 dated 07.07.2022 is not challenged by

either party before the Hon'ble High Court or any other Higher Forums.
Hence, the following order.

ORDER

- 1) The O.As. are partly allowed.
- 2) The respondents are directed to consider the cases of all the applicants / legal heirs carefully and decide as to whether they are entitled for regularization as per G.R. dated 16.10.2012.
- 3) The respondents are directed to make the inquiry as to whether they were working on E.G.S..
- 4) The opportunity be given to all the applicants in the inquiry.
- 5) The respondents are directed to provide the documents of the applicants according to the list forwarded by Tehsildar to provide work to the applicants on E.G.S..
- 6) The respondents are directed to decide the claim of the applicants **within a period of six months.**
- 7) All the O.As. are disposed of accordingly C.As. are also disposed of with no order as to costs.
